

BY-LAW NO. I/61.

A BY LAW REQUIRING THE VACCINATION OF CALVES WITHIN THE
MUNICIPALITY WITH BRUCELLA ABORTUS VACCINE

The council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis
No. 191 of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. All heifer calves within the rural municipality shall be vaccinated with Brucella abortus vaccine, strain 19, and such vaccination shall be done when the calves are not less than four months and not more than ten months after the date of birth of the animal so as to be "Official Vaccinates".
2. All calves vaccinated shall be identified by placing numbered ear tags in the upper fold of the right ear, alternatively, in pure bred animals the ear tattoo number may be used.
3. All calves vaccinated shall be identified on either group or individual certificates provided by the Minister of Agriculture.
4. The council shall enter into an agreement with the government of Saskatchewan, or a private practicing veterinarian, for the purpose of having all heifer calves vaccinated within the municipality. The charge for this service shall be by mutual agreement between the council and the veterinarian or the government of Saskatchewan but in no case will the charge exceed 75¢ for each head up to ten with no charge thereafter when calves are vaccinated in accordance with department regulations.
5. The order in which calves shall be vaccinated with Brucella abortus vaccine within the municipality shall be determined by the veterinarian.
6. The owners of all calves to be vaccinated shall provide the veterinarian with such assistance as may be required and the council may require such owners to assemble such calves in suitable numbers to assist in completing the program of calfhood vaccination in that area.
7. The council may collect from each owner of calves vaccinated as provided herein, the amount paid by the council on behalf of such owner and may specify the date on or before which payment shall be made by the said owners, or the council may direct the veterinarian to collect the said fee from each owner of calves to be vaccinated.
8. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this by-law shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty By-law of the municipality.
9. By-law No. 3/60 approved May 19th, 1960 is hereby repealed.
