BYLAW NO. 1/63

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE PLANTING OF TREES, SHRUBS, ETC. WITHIN ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET FROM THE CENTRE OF MUNICIPAL ROADS

The council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191 of the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The planting of trees or shrubs, orthe placing of stone piles, portable structures, machinery or other objects within one hundred and fifty feet from the centre of any road other than a provincial highway is hereby prohibited.
- 2. This bylaw shall not apply to any road in the following hamlet areas:

Sun Valley, South Lake, Rowletta

3. Any person found guilty of infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality, being number 2/58 passed on the 2nd day of June, 1958.
