## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS by Section 3 of The Pest Control Act, the Minister of Agriculture may by order published in The Saskatchewan Gazette declare any animal, insect or disease that he deems likely to be destructive of or dangerous to any crops, grains, livestock or other property to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

WHEREAS the said Minister has by order published in the issue of The Saskatchewan Gazette for June 17,1957, declared grasshoppers to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

WHEREAS power is vested in the Council of the Municipality by Section 12, of The Pest Control Act, to enact bylaws for the control of any pest to which such Act relates;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- In this bylaw the expression:
  - " Chemical Distribution Outlet" means any place of business or outlet that supplies grasshopper control chemical";
  - " Committee " means members appointed by the municipality;
  - " Council " means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191";
  - " Municipality " means the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191;
  - " Owner " includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the municipality.
- (2) The Council shall, in each year, appoint a committee, to be known as the ' Grasshopper Control Committee ' to administer the bylaw.
- (3) Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshoppers:
  - He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals on his land, that is, in his opinion and or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application; and
  - He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the center line of the road allowance adjoining his land and the nearest boundary of that said land, that is, in his opinion and or the opinion of the committee, warrants such application.
- (4) If the owner fails to spray and control the grasshoppers on his or her land, and on the recommendation of the committee, the municipality will spray the infested area and all costs will be charged against the said property.
- (5) The owner shall bear the costs and the responsibility of obtaining all chemicals and supplies needed to control grasshoppers under this bylaw

GRALITY OF (6) This bylaw shall remain in force until repealed by Bylaw of the Municipality. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY
