## BYLAW No. 2/76

## A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS

The council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- I. In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public highwa, within the municipality as defined in The Highways Act., other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
- 2. Signs containing the word "stop" shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

3. Signs containing the word "yield" shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following locations:

4. All signs erected pursuant to sections 2 and 3 hereof shall be erected not less than ten feet and not more than fifty feet from the near edge of the intersected roadway.

5. The provisions of The Vehicles Act shall apply, whereve applicable to every sign erected pursuant to sections 2 and 3.

6. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamps with any sign erected pursuant to this bylaw.

7. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw shall be faulty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penultic in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality
