BYLAW 2/2017

A BYLAW OF THE RM OF MARQUIS NO. 191 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO PROVIDE FOR INCURRING A DEBT IN THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000)FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A NEW MUNICIPAL SHOP.

WHEREAS the Council of the RM of Marquis No. 191 deems it desirable and necessary to incur a debt as set out in Section 162 and 163 of *The Municipalities Act*, in the amount of THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) for the purpose of building a new municipal shop; and

WHEREAS the taxable assessment as shown on the last revised assessment roll thereof, being that for the year 2016 is the sum of SEVENTY SIX MILLION, TWO HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR THOUSAND, SIXTY DOLLARS (\$76,234,060.00);

WHEREAS the amount of the existing long term debt of the RM of Marquis No. 191 Is the sum of ZERO DOLLARS (\$0.00); no part of which either principal or interest is in arrears;

NOW, THEREFORE; Council of the RM of Marquis No. 191 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to Sections 162 and 163 of *The Municipalities Act*, the R.M. Of Marquis No.191 requires Saskatchewan Municipal Board approval to incur a debt in the form of a loan in the amount of THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS(\$300,000); and
- 2. The amount of said debt shall be paid in ten(10) annual instalments of THIRTY SEVEN
 THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND ELEVEN DOLLARS AND 56/100 (\$37,211.56) of principal and interest at a rate of four decimal zero eight (4.08%) per centum per annum, in the years 2018 to 2027 inclusive.
- 3. The source or sources of money to be used to pay the principal and interest owing under this bylaw will be revenue derived from increased mill rates. In any event, any other available source of revenue.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of approval being used by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board , Local Government Committee .
