VILLAGE OF MARQUIS

BYLAW NO. 6-2018

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF OCCUPANTS OF TRAILERS OR MOBILE HOMES

THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF MARQUIS IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the 'Trailer License' Bylaw.

DEFINITION

- 1.1 In this bylaw including this section:
 - a) "assessed trailers" means trailers that are assessed and are taxable by the municipality.
 - b) "council" means the council of the Village of Marquis.
 - c) "municipality" means the Village of Marquis
 - d) "occupant" includes: a person residing on land or in a building
 - e) "Permanent basis" means either year-round occupancy, or occupancy by persons who do not maintain elsewhere a usual or normal place of residence.
 - f) "portable building" means any building that is portable and is not permanent
 - g) "stored trailer" means a trailer that is located on a property only for the purpose of storing such trailer, for use at any location other than the property upon which it is stored.
 - h) "trailer" means any vehicle so constructed that it is suitable for being attached to a motor vehicle for the purpose of being drawn, is propelled by the motor vehicle or is a self-propelled camping unit and is capable of being used for the living, sleeping, or eating accommodation of any persons. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing includes, a park model trailer, a tent trailer, a camper trailer, a recreational trailer, a fifth wheel, a bus converted into a motor home, a motor home, or a truck camper.
- i) "trailer, park model" means a manufactured building which is used as a recreational vehicle or building that meets the following criteria:
 - a. Built on a single chassis mounted on wheels; and
 - b. Designed to facilitate relocation from time to time; and
 - c. Designed as living quarters for seasonal camping which may be connected to utilities necessary for the operation of installed fixtures and appliances

APPLICATION

- 1.2 This bylaw does not apply to:
 - a) Assessed Trailers
 - b) Stored Trailers

- 1.3 The occupant of every trailer, mobile home, or portable building used for residential purposes within the confines of the Village of Marquis shall within five days of the expiration of thirty days from the date of entry into the town register himself or herself as the occupant of such trailer, mobile home, or portable building with the administrator of the Village of Marquis and obtain a license.
- 2. The license fee payable to the Village of Marquis will be as prescribed in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming a part of this Bylaw, billed monthly.
- 3. The fee prescribed by Schedule "A" of this Bylaw shall be based upon the outside length of the trailer or the outside dimension including all attachments and garages except decks.

CONTRAVENTION

 Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw, shall be subject to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Marquis.

COMING INTO FORCE

- 5. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
- 6. Bylaw 5/65 is hereby repealed.

SCHEDULE "A"

Trailers or Mobile Homes including all attachments and garages except decks are measured by the outside length of the trailer and shall be as follows:

Maximum Outside Dimension

Fee

Less than 25 feet

\$75.00 per month

25 to 34 feet

\$100.00 per month

35 to 44 feet

\$150.00 per month

45 feet and over

\$200.00 per month
