BYLAW NO. 8/64

A BYLAW RESPECTING FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS

The Council of The Village of Marquis, of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:-

- 1. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, no person shall discharge any firearm, airgun, spring gun, or any class or type thereof within the village.
- 2. The council may authorize a designated officer of the village to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit in writing, entitling it to operate within a certain designated area for the purpose or supervised target practice or similar activities.
- 3. No such club shall operate at any time without such a permit, and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit, when requested to do so by the Village Constable, license inspector or other authorized person.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of Section 5, no person shall sell fireworks of any kind within the village, and no person shall set off within the village fireworks of any kind.
- 5. The council may authorize a designated officer of the village to issue to any person or persons a permit in writing for the sale and for the setting off of fireworks or for a display thereof in accordance with such terms and conditions as the council may prescribe.
 - 6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties as provided in The General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
